##### **A. 2018-2019 Budget Presentation/Discussion**

Superintendent Smith presented revised budget slides for Board feedback. Minor changes will be made to the presentation.

Scott Sugarman presented Pupil Services budget highlights which includes the expansion of social skills at the middle school, diagnostic testing, new student support services, adding a Board Certified Behavior Analyst, and adding 2 Behavior Technicians.

Ian Polun presented the Curriculum Department budget highlights which includes adding summer curriculum writing and adding stipends for funding the TEAM mentor program which is no longer funded by the State.

Heather Burns presented the Technology Department budget highlights which includes a complete campus infrastructure plan, support of the Summit Learning Program at the high school, hardware re-deployment and upgrades, staff reorganization of the technology department, and adding Chrome books for grade 9 students.

William Birch presented Facilities Department budget highlights which includes middle school renovations, adding sun control in the elementary school, building numbering, new equipment, and possible reductions in electricity and oil costs.
